PARISH HISTORY

Our Lady of the Assumption Church, owned and operated by the Society of Saint Pius X, is an 11,000-square-foot Neo-Gothic church on a 13-acre property purchased in 2001. Completed in 2010, the first Mass was offered on December 8th—the Feast of the Immaculate Conception—by the founding rector, Fr. Adam Purdy, FSSPX. The church was consecrated by Bishop Bernard Fellay in 2011. The sanctuary features historic marble altar pieces from the former Our Lady of the Assumption Church on Gilbert Avenue in Cincinnati, hand crafted in Italy in 1924 from Botticino and Carrara marble, quarried from the same source of stone used by Michelangelo for his famous works such as *David* and the *Pietà*.

OUR CATHOLIC SCHOOLS

The parish provides a traditional, classical education through our two schools for students from Kindergarten through 12th grade.

Our Lady of the Sacred Heart Academy (OLSHA), the girls school, is directed by the Dominican Teaching Sisters of Fanjeaux, France.

Assumption Academy, the boy's schools, is taught in part by the priests of the Society of Saint Pius X, is currently operating in the church basement while a new school building is under construction, planned to open in Fall of 2027.

...It is the Sacrifice dedicated by our Redeemer at the Cross, and repeated every day on the Altar.

If you wish to hear the Mass as it should be heard, you must follow with eye, heart, and mouth all that happens at the Altar.

Further, you must pray with the priest the holy words said by him in the Name of Christ and which Christ says by him. You have to associate your heart with the holy feelings which are contained in these words and in this manner you ought to follow all that happens on the Altar.
